**BAPTISM:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated monthly on the last Saturday of the month at 2 p.m. To prepare for the Sacrament, parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptism catechesis that is scheduled every second Tuesday of the month at 7 p.m.. All Godparents have to have attained the age of 16; not be the child's parent; be a practicing Catholic and also need to have received the sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, First Eucharist, and Confirmation. Each Godparent needs to provide a Letter/Certificate signed and sealed from their own Parish stating that they are a member in good standing and have completed the baptism class. For more information and registration forms, please contact the office.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** Couples planning to marry in the Church must meet with a priest for several preparation meetings and attend an Engaged Encounter weekend. A minimum of 6 months is required.

**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Please notify the office or rectory when a family member is about to be hospitalized, is hospitalized, or is confined at home due to sickness, or aging. In the hospital, ask your nurse to page the on-call Hospital Chaplain. The Chaplain will call the priest assigned for the day to the hospital to provide spiritual care and meet the sacramental needs of the patient.

**FUNERALS:** We ask families to call the Parish Office **PRIOR** to any arrangements with the Mortuary to avoid conflicts.

**HOUSE BLESSINGS:** If possible, we ask parishioners to schedule house blessings at least one week in advance.

(Reflection on Sunday Gospel)

**"Great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire"** This passage (Matthew 15:21) describes the only occasion in which Jesus ministered outside of Jewish territory. (Tyre and Sidon were fifty miles north of Israel and still exist today in modern Lebanon.) A Gentile woman, a foreigner who was not a member of the Jewish people, puts Jesus on the spot by pleading for his help. At first Jesus seemed to pay no attention to her, and this made his disciples feel embarrassed. Jesus does this to test the woman to awaken faith in her.

**What is the new Evangelization?**

The New Evangelization is a notion principally advanced by St. John Paul II. In contrast to the traditional evangelization of non-Christian peoples, the new evangelization focuses on reaching out to unchurched Catholics, what others would call "cultural Catholics," those that are Catholic in name but not in mind, heart and soul.

There are four essential goals: First, we must recognize that cultural developments of recent times offer new opportunities for evangelization. In particular, new technologies that facilitate mass communication and personal interaction are to be used to share Christ with others. Everything from EWTN to tweets from pastors to my-Parish App on smart phones is an example of this.

Second, the new evangelization should avoid compromise with any cultural assumptions that in theory or practice deny the dignity of any class of human beings. Messages of power, wealth, honor and endless pleasure seem normal and healthy in our culture but are usually the antithesis of the message of Jesus Christ.

Third, the new evangelization must overwhelmingly affirm the love of God and of Jesus Christ. People are won over by lives lived out in love, not words of coercion. Finally, each of us is called to a deeper appreciation of the value of holiness in one's life and communion with others in the name and body of Christ.
